	\$10.00 minimum charge. Contaminated loads will be assessed an additional \$50.00/Ton fee.
\$36.00/Ton	Asphalt Shingles - Clean asphalt shingles (Non Aspestos) from residential dwellings of (4) units or less and must be
	free from cedar shakes, wood, metal and other residential debris/trash. All weighed vehicles over 500 lbs are
	prorated at \$36.00/Ton with a \$10.00 minimum charge.

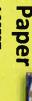

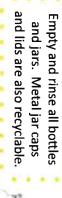
